It's in Our Hand: Your Participation in the 2010 Census Matters.

- Every year, more than \$300 million in federal funds is awarded to states and communities based on census data. That's more than \$3 trillion over a 10-year period.
- Census data guide local decision-makers in important community planning efforts, including where to build new roads, hospitals and schools.
- Census data affect your voice in Congress by determining how many seats each state will have in the U.S. House of Representatives.

- The Census Bureau DOES NOT release or share information that identifies individual respondents or their household for 72 years.

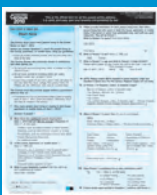
Census Data Usage

- Census data determine the number of seats each state will have in the U.S. House of Representatives. Census data also can help determine the allocation of federal funds for community services, such as school lunch programs and senior citizen centers, and new construction, such as hospitals and highways.
